### **CANOEING TRIP!**

As part of our sports week, the children in Year 2 have been invited to participate in a canoeing activity session in Hurley with the RBWM Outdoor Education Project. It is a **fully funded** trip. The children will be collected by an RBWM minibus, with fully fitted seatbelts, and taken to Hurley for a picnic and a half day canoeing session, run by fully qualified instructors. They will then be returned to school for home time.

The classes will go on the following days:

**2VA Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> June in the morning**  
**2GC Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> June in the afternoon**  
**2DW Friday 30<sup>th</sup> June in the morning**  
**2KM Friday 30<sup>th</sup> June in the afternoon**

The morning sessions leave school at 9am so please ensure the children arrive promptly to school.

On their canoeing day, the children should come into school wearing their PE kit (tracksuit bottoms if it is chilly). Sun cream should be applied before school.

The children will also need a named bag with the following inside:

- A complete change of weather appropriate clothes (including shoes and underwear)
- Old **trainers/water shoes** to wear whilst canoeing (they will get wet)
- A jacket – preferably waterproof
- A towel
- A sun hat, if sunny
- A packed lunch and water bottle

We are very excited about the children being involved in such a wonderful, fun activity as it also promotes teamwork. What a great way to celebrate their time at Alwyn School!
