Apply for Free School Meals (Pupil Premium Funding) – it's quick and easy using the online form at:

Even though, as an Infant school, your child receives a Universal Free School Meal, if you are receiving certain benefits and would have been entitled to Free School Meals previously, the school could also receive additional funding to help support your child's education including funding for **before/after school clubs, swimming and school trips BUT YOU MUST APPLY**. No one else will know you have registered and it will not affect any other benefits you are claiming.

Do you qualify?

Your child will be eligible for Free School Meals/Pupil Premium if you receive any of these benefits:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The Guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit with an annual gross income into the household that is no more than £16,190 provided you are not entitled to Working Tax Credit. If you are entitled to any part of Working Tax Credit, there is no eligibility with the exception of working tax run-on as shown below.
- Working Tax Credit run-on – paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax
- Credit.
- Universal Credit
