School Uniform

The children are looking incredibly smart in their school uniforms. If you are unsure of our uniform policy, please look at the school website for help.

Just a polite reminder, that for safety reasons, jewellery should not be worn in school. The only exceptions are watches. If earrings cannot be taken out, they must be small

Punctuality

Please remember our morning start times. It is very important that children come into school on time and are ready for the start of the school day. It can be disruptive to children emotionally and educationally if they come into a classroom when the lesson has already started and there is not enough time in the day to catch up on missed learning; a lot of learning can take place in 10 minutes! If there is a special circumstance where you know you will be late, please let the office know. All persistent lateness will be followed up

Remember to Order Lunches

If you would like your child to have a school dinner, remember to order it online. The deadline for ordering lunches is 8am on the day.

Please review the menu with your child to check they know what has been chosen for them each day and that they like it. Choose peas or beans, if asked. Lunches for infant age children are fully funded so parents do not pay for them.

If your child does not have a packed lunch, they will be given a jacket potato with beans. We will no longer phone home for lunch orders

Open Door Policy

Here at Alwyn, we have an 'open door' policy. If you have any questions or concerns about anything at all to do with your child's education or well being, please do not hesitate to talk to the class teacher, phone for a chat or make an appointment if you would like a face to face meeting.



Attendance

It is very important that children attend school every day, unless they are unwell. Please try to make any medical or dental appointments outside of school hours. **P**arents and carers that take children out of school for unauthorised holiday may be subject to penalty fines. The school will only authorise absence for holiday in exceptional circumstances.

Reception Children

Ask me who my new teacher is and what I am looking forward to doing when I start next week?

You could ask your child these... Ask me what I do when I go into the classroom every morning? Ask me where I put my water bottle and book bag? Ask me how we take the class register? Ask me the name of my class and the adults who help in the class?

On Friday afternoons we have a special 'Golden Book' assembly where we celebrate each others' achievements and highlight children who have been exceptionally polite or kind.


If your son or daughter has done or achieved something special outside of school, let us know so we can recognise and celebrate their achievements during this special assembly.
