Dear Parents/Carers

Extra-Curricular Activities for Autumn Term 2024

I am able to confirm that our range of before/after school clubs will start again for the autumn term from **Monday 16th September 2024 for Years One and Two only.**

All clubs, except our choir club, are managed and run by external providers. There is not a member of Alwyn staff supervising these clubs. As parents, you will be required to book onto clubs directly with the individual club provider and payment should be made directly to them. Mr Baker has requested that you only apply for one of the football clubs, not both.

Details of each club are on the attached timetable, including which year group can apply. You will find each of the club's flyers with their details and how to apply on our website. Please note that some clubs have not opened their booking system yet – **please check the timetable for dates.** It remains that, with morning clubs, the children are escorted to their class once the club has finished and with afternoon clubs, the children are escorted to the club at the end of the school day.

If you wish to apply for our choir club, registration and payment will open on MCAS on Friday 19th July. The deadline for applications and payment is 31st August 2024.

Sadly, the after school and breakfast cookery clubs and the morning ballet club will no longer be running. However, we have two new clubs starting in September; sewing on a Monday and TechyTots on a Wednesday, both after school.

The duration of the clubs for this term will be 11 weeks except for Yoga, Sewing and Choir Club, which will be for 10 weeks due to the INSET Day on Monday 4th November.

For all sports clubs, children are to wear PE kit or tracksuit with plimsolls or trainers. Children should have their hair tied back and jewellery removed. It is a good idea for the children to bring a named water bottle to each club in case they get thirsty.

If you are in receipt of certain benefits and are registered with the school as claiming free school meals (not universal free school meals), you are entitled to **one free club for one term each academic year.** Please reserve your place directly with the club and also tell the school which club you have applied for. If you are successful in your application, the cost will be paid by the school.

For Football clubs and Multi-Skills, if you are eligible for a free club, a special code to use when booking will be sent to you in a separate email.
