can use these toilets too.

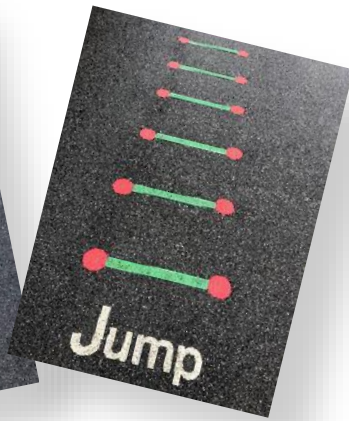


The main playground

This is the same as when you were in Reception.

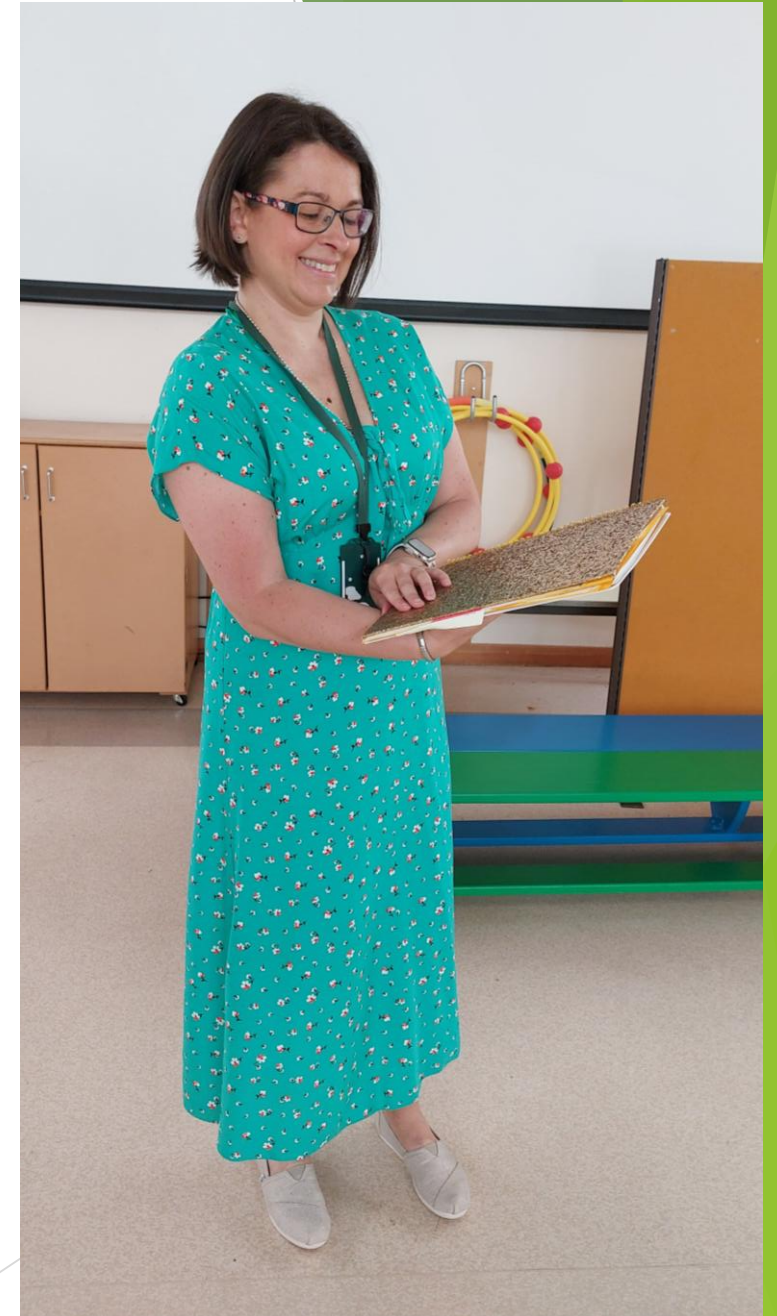


We have assembly in the hall.

with Year One children.



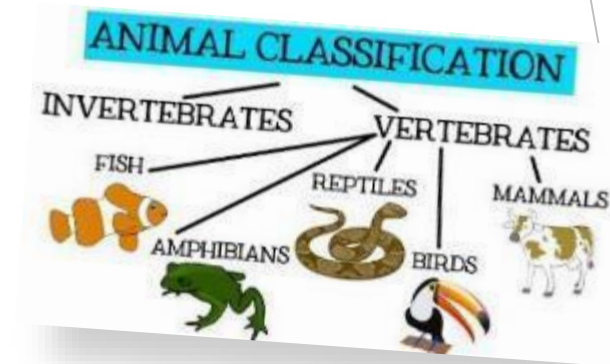
Do you like football?

Here are some topics we cover in Year One.

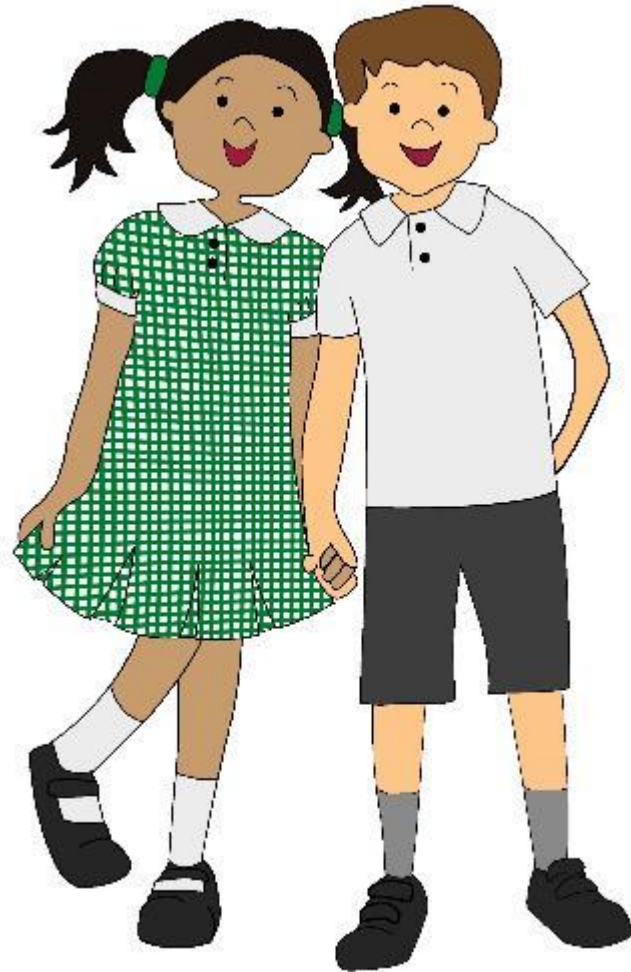




Visiting Odds Farm is one of the super trips we go on in Year One.
