- Telling the time o'clock, half past, quarter



Reading - How to help at home

- Read every day at home.
- Practise the phonics sheets.
- Read to your child a variety of texts e.g. recipes, shopping lists, games instructions, news.
- Talk to your child about what they have read.
- Discuss new words and their meaning.
- Predict what might happen next.
- Reading has a huge influence on children's writing.
- Give plenty of praise.

Writing in Year 2

- Capital letters, full stops, question marks, exclamation marks
- Conjunctions- or, and, but, when, if, that, because
- Types of sentences
- Present tense and past tense e.g. I jump, I jumped
- Using phonics to spell words
- Spell the Year 1 and Year 2 Common Exception words
- Form letters and numbers correctly and at the correct height
- Spaces between words

Sharing Presentations

In year 2, we ask the children to prepare and share a short sharing presentation (a talk, no longer than 3 minutes).

Autumn Term: choose to do it on anything that interests them.

- Spring Term: to learn a short poem and perform it to the class
- Summer Term: choose to do it on anything that interests them.

You can email photos, powerpoints, notes into the class teacher to support them.
