Where do I go to the toilet and wash my hands?

They are just by the cloakroom.

There are lots of playground toys you can use.

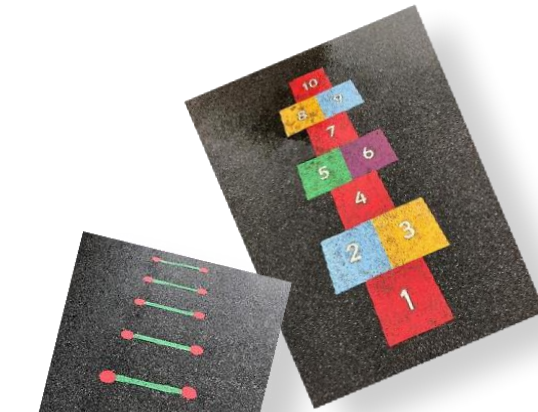
There is a fabulous sand pit, play train, tunnel and tyres.
